CATEGORIES

Your choice of category for your used item will have an impact on how well it will sell. For standard curriculum, the grade or subject is often written on the front of the book. Sometimes items fit into more than one category and other times they don't seem to fit any at all. Here is a guide.

SUBJECT	EXAMPLES
Art	Books that teach art, crafts, drawing, general coloring books, etc.
Bible	Bible curriculum, Bible studies, theology books, Bible study helps such as a concordance, Bible dictionary, Bible atlas, etc.
College Prep	SAT and ACT study books and other materials to help students prepare for college.
Critical Thinking or Logic	Critical Thinking Press should be labeled "Critical Thinking". All other logic materials should be labeled "Logic".
Electronics	Computer games, DVD's, CD's, etc.
English/Language Arts	All English materials, including phonics, reading, grammar, literature, writing, language mechanics, and spelling. Include dictionaries, thesaurus, and spelling reference books.
Fiction	All fiction, including historical novels. If you have a set, label it as a set. If it is part of a specific curriculum, you have the option of selling it as a full curriculum.
Foreign Languages	Anything for learning a foreign language, including flash cards, dictionaries, etc.
Games	Games, puzzles, and items used for playing outside such as jump ropes.
Grades Pre-K- through 12	Grade level specific materials, such as a math or English curriculum. When labeling, list the grade level. It will go on a table for that grade.
Health & P.E.	Items used for P.E. instruction or health, such as anatomy & physiology flash cards, models of the human body, etc.
History, Geography, and Social Studies	Coloring books, workbooks, model cut-outs, and other materials specifically for use with studying history, geography, or social studies.
Home Economics or Life Skills	Books that teach cooking, sewing, gardening, personal finance, and any other materials related to life skills.
Reference	Resources on home schooling, special needs, parenting, marriage, home management, testing, etc.

Math	In addition to textbooks, include flash cards, workbooks, manipulatives, materials that teach money, time, etc.
Music	Musical instruments, music books, keyboards, etc.
Science	Science workbooks, coloring books, microscopes, lab supplies, and resource books on various science or technology topics
Sonlight (SL)	Curriculum that is specific to <i>Sonlight</i> . There will be a separate table. Fiction books may be sold separately as Fiction, unless part of a set.
My Father's World (<i>MFW</i>)	Curriculum specific to <i>My Father's World</i> . Includes sets or curriculum guides Fiction will be found in the Fiction area, unless labeled as a set
Classical Conversations (CC)	Curriculum that is specifically for Classical Conversations.
Good & the Beautiful (GB)	Material that is specific to the Good and the Beautiful curriculum.
